The Province of KwaZulu-Natal, Department of Transport, invites tenders from contractors, experienced in roadworks and bridge structures, for the upgrade to Kwamagoda (Nkhukhu) River Bridge 2002 over Kwamagoda River on District Road D59 KM 0.108 in the Pietermaritzburg Region. This project is in the province of KwaZulu-Natal in the district municipality of Umgungundlovu and local municipality of Richmond. The duration of the project is 15 months.

Only tenderers that satisfy the eligibility criteria stipulated in clause C.2.1 of the Tender Data are eligible to have their tenders considered.

Tenders must have a minimum CIDB contractor grading designation of 7CE or higher.

Only tenderers who comply with the functionality criteria for experience of key persons, company past performance in similar Complex projects, and proposed approach and methodology, as stated in the Tender Data, are eligible to be considered for further evaluation.

Only locally produced or locally manufactured goods with a stipulated minimum threshold for local production and content as stated in the Tender Data will be considered. Failure to meet the minimum threshold for local production and content **will** lead to disqualification.

The successful tenderer must subcontract a minimum of 30% of the value of the Constructions Works to Targeted Enterprises through Contract Participation Goals (CPG) for a bidder that is BEE Level 1 EME or QSE that is more than 51% owned by black person(s).

Tenderers shall be required to demonstrate that they will have in their employ during the contract period the necessary personnel satisfying the requirements of the Scope of Work for labor-enhanced competencies for management and supervisory personnel.


