The Province of KwaZulu-Natal, Department of Transport, invites tenders from contractors, experienced in roadworks, for The Provision of Routine and Safety Maintenance on various roads within Nguthu zone in the Nguthu Region. This project is located in the NguTHU Local Municipality under the Umzinyathi District Municipality. The duration of the project is 36 months

Only tenderers that satisfy the eligibility criteria stipulated in clause C.2.1 of the Tender Data are eligible to have their tenders considered.

Tenders must have a minimum CIDB contractor grading designation of 7CE or higher.

The requirements of the CIDB B.U.I.L.D. Programme with respect to Indirect Targeting for Enterprise Development is set at a minimum contribution of 30% of the project's contract value towards development support. This is the support that the successful tenderer must provide on this contract.

The requirements of the CIDB B.U.I.L.D. Programme with respect to the Standard for Skills Development is set at a maximum development support of 0.25% of the project's contract value.

Preference points are offered to tenderers who comply with the requirements of PPPFA Regulations, 2022 as stipulated in clause C.3.11.1 of the Tender Data.

Department of Transport reserves a right not to award more than one contracts per service provider within the region.

Shortlisted bidders might undergo risk assessment where necessary.
