The Province of KwaZulu-Natal, Department of Transport, invites tenders from contractors, experienced in roadworks, for The ZNB02606/00000/00/EST/INF/24/T: PROVISION OF ROUTINE AND SAFETY MAINTENANCE ON VARIOUS ROADS WITHIN EMAZIZINI ZONE 3,BERGVILLE AREA OFFICE,UNDER OKHAHLAMBA LOCAL MUNICIPALITY. The duration of the project is 36 months.

Only tenderers that satisfy the eligibility criteria stipulated in clause C.2.1 of the Tender Data are eligible to have their tenders considered.

Tenders must have a minimum CIDB contractor grading designation of **8CE or higher**.

The requirements of the CIDB B.U.I.L.D. Programme with respect to Indirect Targeting for Enterprise Development is set at a minimum contribution of 30% of the project's contract value towards subcontracting. The Contractor shall also be required to provide developmental support to Targeted Enterprises.

The requirements of the CIDB B.U.I.L.D. Programme with respect to the Standard for Skills Development is set at a development support of 0.25% of the project's contract value. Shortlisted bidders might undergo risk assessment where necessary

Tenderers shall be required to demonstrate that they will have in their employ during the contract period the necessary personnel satisfying the requirements of the Scope of Work for labour-enhanced competencies for management and supervisory personnel.

Preference points are offered to tenderers who comply with the requirements of PPPFA Regulations, 2022 as stipulated in clause C.3.11.1 of the Tender Data.

Shortlisted bidders might undergo risk assessment where necessary.

Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, electronic, e-mailed and late tenders submitted in any other format or form not as detailed in the Tender Data will not be accepted.

The tender offer validity period is twenty-four (24) weeks, calculated from the date of bid closure.

Requirements for sealing, addressing, delivery, opening and assessment of tenders are stated in the Tender Data.

The Tenderers shall be required to sign a register to confirm the submission of both the electronic copy via a USB memory stick and a hard copy of the Tender document. Unsuccessful Tenderers are at liberty to collect their USB memory sticks upon the Department's completion of the bid evaluation processes.
