The Province of KwaZulu-Natal, Department of Transport, invites tenders from contractors, experienced in roadworks, for The Blacktop Patching of Provincial Road P565 (km 0+000 TO km 7+260) AND P308 (km 0+000 To km 5+780) in the Ladysmith Region. This project is in the province of KwaZulu-Natal in the Amajuba DISTRICT and eMadlangeni Local Municipality. The duration of the project is 3 months.

Only tenderers that satisfy the eligibility criteria stipulated in clause C.2.1 of the Tender Data are eligible to have their tenders considered.

Tenders must have a minimum CIDB contractor grading designation of 4CE or higher.

Preference points are offered to tenderers who comply with the requirements of PPPFA Regulations, 2022 as stipulated in clause C.3.11.1 of the Tender Data.

Shortlisted bidders might undergo risk assessment where necessary.

The tender offer validity period is twenty-four (24) weeks, calculated from the date of bid closure.

Requirements for sealing, addressing, delivery, opening and assessment of tenders are stated in the Tender Data.

The Tenderers shall be required to sign a register to confirm the submission of both the electronic copy via a USB memory stick and a hard copy of the Tender document. Unsuccessful Tenderers are at liberty to collect their USB memory sticks upon the Department's completion of the bid evaluation processes.
