The province of KwaZulu-Natal, department of transport, invites tenders from contractors, experienced in roadworks, reinstatement of pipe culverts and retaining wall at km 32 on provincial main road P340 in the uThukela district under cost centre Estcourt the duration of the project is 6 months.

Only tenderers that satisfy the eligibility criteria stipulated in clause C.2.1 of the Tender Data are eligible to have their tenders considered.

Tenders must have a minimum CIDB contractor grading designation of 6CE or higher.

Only tenderers who comply with the functionality criteria for experience of key persons, company past performance in Complex Road projects, i.e. Upgrade Projects as stated in the Tender Data, are eligible to be considered for further evaluation.

Tenderers shall be required to demonstrate that they will have in their employ during the contract period the necessary personnel satisfying the requirements of the Scope of Work for labour-enhanced competencies for management and supervisory personnel.

Preference points are offered to tenderers who comply with the requirements of PPPFA Regulations, 2022 as stipulated in clause C.3.11.1 of the Tender Data.

Shortlisted bidders might undergo risk assessment where necessary.

The tender offer validity period is twenty-four (24) weeks, calculated from the date of bid closure.

Requirements for sealing, addressing, delivery, opening and assessment of tenders are stated in the Tender Data.

The Tenderers shall be required to sign a register to confirm the submission of both the electronic copy via a USB memory stick and a hard copy of the Tender document.
