The Province of KwaZulu-Natal, Department of Transport, invites tenders from contractors, experienced in roadworks, for Blacktop patching of Main Road P38 (km 00+000 TO km 22+500) Within Newcastle Area Office Under Cost Centre Newcastle in the Ladysmith Region. This project is in the province of KwaZulu-Natal in the Amajuba District and Newcastle Local Municipality. The duration of the project is 4 months.

Only tenderers that satisfy the eligibility criteria stipulated in clause C.2.1 of the Tender Data are eligible to have their tenders considered.

Tenders must have a minimum CIDB contractor grading designation of **4CE or higher**.

Tenderers shall be required to demonstrate that they will have in their employ during the contract period the necessary personnel satisfying the requirements of the Scope of Work for labour-enhanced competencies for management and supervisory personnel.

Preference points are offered to tenderers who comply with the requirements of PPPFA Regulations, 2022 as stipulated in clause C.3.11.1 of the Tender Data.

Shortlisted bidders might undergo risk assessment where necessary.
