The Province of KwaZulu-Natal, Department of Transport, invites tenders from contractors, experienced in roadworks, for Blacktop patching of Main Road D96 (km 00+000 TO km 12+000) Within Newcastle Area Office Under Cost Centre Newcastle in the Ladysmith Region. This project is in the province of KwaZulu-Natal in the Amajuba District and Newcastle Local Municipality. The duration of the project is 4 months.

Only tenderers that satisfy the eligibility criteria stipulated in clause C.2.1 of the Tender Data are eligible to have their tenders considered.

Tenders must have a minimum CIDB contractor grading designation of **4CE or higher**.

Preference points are offered to tenderers who comply with the requirements of PPPFA stipulated in clause C.3.11.1 of the Tender Data.

Shortlisted bidders might undergo risk assessment where necessary.
